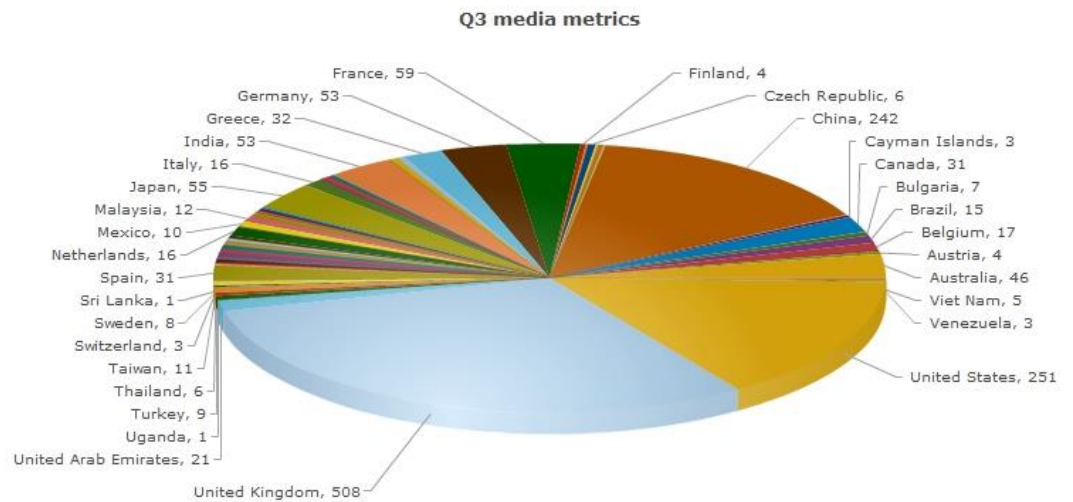




Welcome to the third HVM Catapult Media Roundup. In the 3 months since September, media interest in HVM Catapult has increased, with several very supportive articles in big national titles as well as ongoing positive cover in regional and trade media. Of the 1,539 media items over 3 months, 67% was International coverage, fuelled largely by Centre case studies, such as the windowless fuselage project by CPI, which received widespread coverage in global media. Other key stories were the outcome of the Hauser review, the HVM presence at shows such as the Advanced Engineering Show and the recent announcement of additional funding for HVM Catapult in the Autumn Statement.

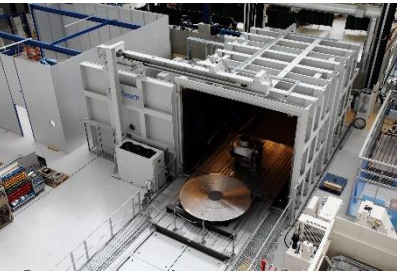
